Rules and Regulations

1. All Department of Game and Inland Fisheries rules apply. Visit <http://www.dgif.virginia.gov>
2. No Alcohol is permitted anytime.
3. No wading will be allowed during the tournament.
4. No trotlines or snares allowed.
5. No Netting of trout.
6. Trout must be at least 7 inches in length.
7. Limit is 6 Strung trout per person.
8. Virginia freshwater license and trout stamp is required.
9. Pushing, fighting or rude behavior will **NOT** be tolerated.
10. All participants must be registered and have an arm band to be able to fish the event. Anyone that does not have an arm band will be asked to leave the fishing area. No one will be allowed in the fishing area without an arm band.
11. Any trout returned into the water must be a viable/living trout. Anyone caught returning a dead fish into the water will be disqualified from the event and asked to leave.

Anyone caught breaking any of the rules and regulations of the event will be disqualified from the event and will be required to leave the premises. Further, they could be charged with a criminal charge. These rules and regulations are only guidelines and are subject to change at any time depending on the circumstances surrounding the incident, at which time you could be disqualified from the event. Stanley Fire Department and Luray Boy Scout Troop #100 are not responsible for any items that are lost or stolen, and said organizations are not responsible for any accidents or injuries incurred during the tournament.

E. Coli Advisory for Creek Use

Participants in this year's annual fishing tournament are advised that recent water quality tests have detected elevated levels of E. coli in the creek. While fishing is still permitted, we recommend taking the following precautions to minimize risk:

1. Avoid direct contact with the water, especially if you have open cuts or wounds.
2. Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and clean water after handling fish or touching the creek water.
3. Refrain from drinking or swallowing creek water.
4. If you have any underlying health concerns or develop symptoms such as nausea, diarrhea, or fever after the event, consult a healthcare professional immediately.

The organizers are committed to your safety but cannot guarantee water quality or assume responsibility for any health issues that may arise. By participating and signing below, you acknowledge and accept these risks.
